### Instructions

This application is to be used for graduate admission only. For Guest or Permit to Register admission, special applications are required. International students must complete a Graduate International Application, not this application. The Graduate International Application includes a checklist of materials required for applying to Wayne State University, a statement of financial support and a bank statement.

### General Requirements

To be considered for graduate admission, you must have completed a university-level four-year degree from a college of recognized standing and have adequate preparation and discernible ability to pursue graduate study in the major field you select. Individual colleges, schools and departments reserve the right to revise or amend their admission requirements beyond the minimum requirements set by the graduate school. Applicants should consult the department of interest concerning current graduate admission standards since admission to many programs is highly competitive.

### Application Fee

U.S. citizens and permanent residents must submit a nonrefundable \$50 application processing fee with this application. Please make check or money order payable to Wayne State University. **Cash and charge cards cannot be accepted.**

### Transcripts

When you submit your graduate application, please request official transcripts from every school, college or university that you have attended since high school. It is important to ask the sending institution to address your transcript to the Office of Graduate Admissions.

If you are a Wayne State graduate, we will request your Wayne State transcript for you. You do not need to do so. We consider "official" only those transcripts sent directly by mail to the admissions office from the issuing institution. The presence of a "seal" does not necessarily make a transcript "official" for admission purposes.

Until we receive your transcripts, our office cannot forward your application to the appropriate academic unit for admission evaluation. Thus, the prompt submission of your records is extremely important. All documents submitted to this office become the property of Wayne State University and cannot be returned to the applicant or released to other institutions.

A hold will be placed on future registrations until all official transcripts are received by the Office of Graduate Admissions.

## Non-Degree Status

If you are not interested in a specific program at this time, you may apply for non-degree admission. Select only a college or school; a major designation is not permitted for non-degree students. No more than nine semester credits, subject to the approval of the graduate officer, may be applied at a later date toward the residence and credit-hour requirements for either a master's or PhD degree.

## Renewal Application

Please note that this application is only applicable for the semester you indicate on the enclosed graduate application. If you do not register for classes within that semester, you must complete a Graduate Renewal Application for the next consecutive semester.

You may file a renewal application up to three semesters after your original application. If you do not register for classes during one of these semesters, you must start the application process all over. This includes completing an application for admission, submitting another application fee and requesting all official transcripts be re-sent to the Office of Graduate Admissions.
